(All requests for reconsideration of a decision must come from the applicant.)

Applications are reviewed on an individual and holistic basis. First and foremost, applicants must be prepared academically for the rigors of college and the academic demands specific to the Purdue college, school, or program to which they are seeking admission. Some of the factors used in the individual review of each application include:

- Successful completion of high school subject matter expectations
- Core grade point average for academic subjects (English, academic math, laboratory science, social studies, and foreign language)
- Strength of student's overall curriculum
- Standardized test scores (SAT or ACT)
- Trends in academic achievement
- Additional information provided by the applicant
- Space availability in the program and time of year the student applied

Regretfully, due to the competitive nature of many Purdue University programs, we are not able to offer admission to every qualified freshman applicant.

You may request reconsideration of your deny decision only if you have new and compelling information that was not included in your original application. In order to appeal your deny decision you must complete all of the steps outlined below. Please keep these factors in mind:

- Appeals must be made in writing—not by phone or e-mail.
- Appeals must be made *by the applicant*.
- Appeals must include new and compelling academic or personal information not previously reported.
- The appeal form and all supporting documents must be submitted together.
- Only one appeal will be accepted and the resulting decision will be considered final.
- **Deadline:** Appeals must be received by May 1 for fall applicants.
