

APPLICATION FEE

A \$50 non-refundable application fee (payable in U.S. funds by check or money order) is required from students who have not attended a Purdue University campus.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The following items are required for an application to receive admission consideration:

- a completed application with responses to all items;
- a high school transcript which includes grades for all courses completed;
- an official transcript from each college or university attended for transfer students; and
- SAT or ACT results, which must be sent from the testing agency. This item is waived for applicants who have completed one year of full-time college work or have been out of high school for three years.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Applications should be completed and submitted to the Purdue University Office of Admissions at least 30 days prior to the start of any given semester. There is no assurance that applications received fewer than 30 days before the semester starts will be processed. Applications will not be accepted after the first day of classes.

FINANCIAL AID

Students interested in receiving financial aid should complete the following steps:

- Apply for admission to Purdue University
- File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) with the College Scholarship Service and designate Purdue University, West Lafayette, as a recipient of the analysis. The FAFSA may be obtained through high school guidance offices or online through the Purdue Division of Financial Aid, www.purdue.edu/DFSA. To receive preferential consideration for available funds, the FAFSA should be filed by March 1 of the year the student will begin attending Purdue.
