D. Students who successfully complete the dual credit course will receive appropriate course credit and a Purdue University transcript certifying that the credit is applicable towards degree requirements at Purdue University and other institutions. Whether or not that the use of that credit is allowed by any institution other than Purdue University is under the sole discretion of that institution.

IV. Student Academic Standards

- A. To receive credit for Purdue University dual credit courses students must complete an application, be accepted as a **non-degree high school** student, pay tuition to the Bursar by the designated due date, and pass the course according to Purdue University standards. To validate compliance with Purdue academic standards, graded exams and assignments will be given by Purdue University faculty teaching the course, and course grades will be reported to the high school.
- B. Student applications will be reviewed individually and admitted according to the same holistic admission standards used by Purdue University. Students must meet the individual department prerequisites for admission to specific courses. Students also must be recommended by the appropriate teacher, a guidance counselor, or a principal.

V. Tuition and Fees

- A. Tuition will be charged at a rate of \$25 for each Purdue credit hour as determined by the State of Indiana.
- B. Students who qualify for free and reduced lunches and meet the standards for admission will have their tuition waived upon providing documentation of said need.
- C. Students who qualify as children of disabled veterans and meet the standards for admission will have their tuition waived upon providing documentation.
- D. Students will be billed directly by the Office of the Bursar at Purdue University and will not receive a transcript until credits are paid.
